Two unseen passages of total 350 words with a variety of questions including 4 marks for vocabulary.

Only prose passages will be used. One will be factual and the other will be discursive.

- (i) **Passage 1**—100 words (6 Marks), Six Multiple Choice Questions testing local and global understanding including 2 questions on vocabulary—one testing the knowledge of similar word and the other testing the knowledge of opposite word.
- (ii) **Passage 2**—250 words (9 Marks), Nine Comprehension questions testing local and global understanding including 2 questions on vocabulary—one testing the knowledge of similar word and the other of opposite word.
